Class Information:

- **Tuition Fee:** \$1,900 (includes textbook & testing fee)
- **Class Begins:** May 30, 2023
- **Class Ends:** July 11, 2023
- **Class Meets:** Tuesdays & Thursdays 4:30pm to 8:00pm at the HACTC (Room 144), or Alice Peck Day Hospital (APD)

- **Required documentation:**
 1. Hepatitis B vaccination
 2. PPD (TB) test
 3. Flu vaccination
 4. Covid-19 vaccination (or medical or religious exemption)
 5. Tdap
 6. MMR

The Licensed Nursing Assistant course meets Vermont and New Hampshire requirements for LNA licensure contingent upon passing the state exam. Course final exam conducted by Prometrics.

Financial Assistance:
