Class Description:

Introduction to Welding class includes; metal shop safety, general metal fabrication skills, and basic instruction in Oxy-fuel welding, Oxy-fuel cutting, manual plasma cutting, SMAW (stick) welding, GMAW (MIG) welding. Student projects are encouraged!

Advanced class includes GTAW (TIG) welding, advanced skills in SMAW, development of certification skills in SMAW, and advanced fabrication skills.
